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COME NOW the Iowa Board of Dietetics ("Board") and Jane Reinhardt-Martin ("Respondent"), and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4), enter into the following Settlement Agreement and Final Order ("Agreement") of the contested case currently on file.

1. Respondent is licensed to practice as a dietitian in the state of Iowa. Respondent was issued Iowa license number 01316 to practice as a dietitian in the state of Iowa on April 6, 1998. Respondent's license will next expire on June 15, 2008.
2. Respondent's current address as reported to the Board is 935-25<sup>th</sup> St., Moline, IL 61265.
3. The Board has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this Agreement.
4. A Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges was filed against the Respondent on June 1, 2007, and is scheduled for hearing on September 7, 2007.
5. Execution of this Agreement constitutes the resolution of this contested case. Respondent has a right to a hearing on the charges, but waives her right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to appeal, by freely and voluntarily agreeing to this Agreement. Once entered, this Agreement shall have the force and effect of a disciplinary order entered following a contested case hearing.

6. Respondent is freely and voluntarily entering into this Agreement, and she agrees that the State's counsel may present this Agreement to the Board.

7. This Agreement is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board approves this Agreement, it becomes the final disposition of this matter. If the Board fails to approve this Agreement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

8. This Agreement shall be part of the permanent record of Respondent and shall be considered by the Board in determining the nature and severity of any disciplinary action to be imposed in the event of any future violations.

9. This Agreement, as well as the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges, are public records available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapter 22.

10. The Board's approval of this Agreement shall constitute a FINAL ORDER of the Board.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

11. **Permanent Restriction against Clinical or Institutional Practice.** Respondent shall be permanently barred from working, either as an employee, consultant, independent contractor or in any other capacity, as a dietitian in a clinic, hospital, nursing home or mental health facility.

12. **Restriction against Providing Individual Assessments.** Respondent shall be restricted from providing individual assessments of clients in her practice of dietetics unless and until she submits a request to the Board to remove this restriction, in which case the Board shall consider the request and if granted, will prescribe specific continuing education and practice monitoring conditions as a requirement for removal of

the restriction.

**13. Reporting of Performance Evaluations and Discipline.** For a period of two (2) years, Respondent shall provide the Board with information regarding:

- a. Performance evaluations, including copies of any correspondence, report or other written record regarding Respondent's compliance with any contracts or other arrangements, formal or informal, written or oral, for the provision of dietitian or nutritional services.
- b. Disciplinary matters or actions imposed against, or restrictions placed upon or otherwise affecting, Respondent in the practice of dietetic or nutritional services, including copies of any correspondence, reprimands, termination of services, sanctions, citations or any other written records relating thereto.

**14. Payment of Penalty.** Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), payable within sixty (60) days after Board approval of this Agreement.

**15. Additional Requirements.**

- a. Respondent shall obey all federal, state, and local statutes and regulations governing the practice of dietetics.
- b. Respondent shall make a personal appearance before the Board upon request. The Respondent shall be given reasonable notice of the date, time, and place for appearance.

**16. Failure to Comply.** In the event the Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms or provisions of this Agreement, the Board may initiate appropriate

action to revoke or suspend the Respondent's license or to impose other licensee discipline as authorized by Iowa Code section 272C.3(2)(a).

**This settlement agreement and final order is approved by the board on September 7, 2007.**
