TO THE ABOVE NAMED RESPONDENT:

The Iowa Board of Social Work Examiners has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 17A, 154C, and 272C.

Licenses issued by the Board are subject to the laws of the state of Iowa and to the administrative rules of the Board.

Respondent Bruce Enger was issued license number 03652 to practice as an independent social worker in the state of Iowa on June 9, 1998, as recorded in the permanent records in the office of the Board. Respondent's license to practice independent level social work in Iowa expired December 31, 2000.

Respondent's current address as reported to the Board is 16479 Highway 151, Monticello, Iowa, 52310.

COUNT I

Pursuant to Iowa Code sections 147.2 and 154C.2 and 645 Iowa Administrative Code 282.2(12)"q", 282.2(17)"b", and 283.2(26), Respondent is charged with practicing social work without an active license to do so and with representing himself as a licensed social worker when his license had lapsed or been placed on inactive status.

CIRCUMSTANCES OF COUNT I

1. Respondent was licensed as an independent social worker on June 9, 1998. Respondent's license expired on December 31, 2000.
2. Respondent continued provide social work services which require an active license, including the provision of psychosocial therapy, after his license had expired.
3. Respondent continued to represent himself as a licensed social worker after his license had expired.

4. Respondent offered to provide supervision to other social workers and mental health counselors which required that he hold an active license to practice, after his license had expired.

#### FINDING OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 14, 2005, the Iowa Board of Social Work Examiners found probable cause to file this Statement of Charges and to order that a hearing be set in this case.
