COME NOW the Iowa Board of Physical and Occupational Therapy (Board) and Julia M. Hargrave (Respondent), and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4), enter into the following Settlement Agreement and Final Order of the contested case currently on file against the Respondent:

- 1. The Respondent is licensed to practice as an occupational therapy assistant and holds license number 00616. That license is active and will expire on January 15, 2014.
- 2. A Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges has been filed against the Respondent. A contested case hearing in this matter is scheduled for December 21, 2012.
- 3. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges.
- 4. Execution of this Settlement Agreement and Final Order constitutes the resolution of this contested case. Respondent has a right to a hearing on the charges, but waives her right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to appeal, by freely and voluntarily agreeing to this Settlement Agreement and Final Order. Once entered, this Order shall have the force and effect of a disciplinary order entered following contested case hearing.
- 5. Respondent is freely and voluntarily entering into this Settlement Agreement and Final Order, and she agrees that the State's counsel may present this agreement to the Board.
- 6. This Agreement is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board approves this agreement, it becomes the final disposition of this matter. If the Board fails to approve this agreement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

- 7. This Settlement Agreement and Final Order as well as the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges are public records available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapter 22.
- 8. The Board's approval of this Agreement shall constitute a FINAL ORDER of the Board.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 9. Respondent is hereby formally CITED for her failure to comply with Board rules and for making misrepresentations on her renewal application. Respondent is WARNED that such conduct could subject her to additional discipline in the future.
- 10. Respondent shall complete all the continuing education she was required to complete for her January, 2012, renewal. Respondent shall have ninety (90) days to complete all of the required continuing education, and submit documentation of that completion to the Board. The 90 days shall begin to run on the date of the Board's acceptance of this Agreement.
- 11. None of the continuing education obtained in fulfillment of this Agreement shall be used towards future renewals of Respondent's license.
- 12. Respondent shall pay to the Board a \$250.00 fine. Such fine shall be due within 30 days of the Board's acceptance of this Agreement.
- 13. Respondent understands that violation of this Agreement constitutes grounds for further discipline.
