The Board is presented with a Motion to Dismiss the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges in the above entitled case that was scheduled for hearing on December 13, 2011. The Motion to Dismiss is granted.

- 1. On September 7, 2010, the Board filed a Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges against the Respondent, alleging that he engaged in unethical conduct and/or practice harmful or detrimental to the public.
- 2. A contested case hearing was held before the Board on December 7, 2010.
- 3. On February 16, 2011, the Board issued its Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law, Decision, and Order.
- 4. As part of the Order, the Board directed Respondent to pay a \$75 hearing fee and \$578.75 in costs for the court reporter. The \$653.75 in hearing fees and costs was to be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the decision.
- 5. Because the Respondent had not remitted payment of \$653.75 in hearing fees and costs to the Board, on September 6, 2011 the Board filed a statement of charges against Respondent for non-payment of hearing fees and costs.
- 6. Following the filing of the statement of charges, the Respondent remitted the fees and costs to the Board.
- 7. The above-captioned Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges should be dismissed with prejudice.
- 8. The dismissal is in the interest of justice.
