IN THE MATTER OF Gregory Haines, D.C. License No. A05751 RESPONDENT.)))))	CASE NO. 09-021 SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER
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Pursuant to Iowa Code ' ' 17A.10 and 272C.3(4) (2013), the Iowa Board of Chiropractic ("Board") and Gregory Haines ("Respondent") enter into the following Settlement Agreement and Final Order ("Order") to settle a contested case currently pending before the Board.

The allegations contained in the Statement of Charges against Respondent shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the Board and Respondent stipulate as follows:


1. Respondent was issued Iowa license A05751 to practice as a chiropractor on November 2, 1993.
2. Respondent's license is currently active and will expire on June 30, 2014.
3. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of these proceedings.
4. A Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges was filed against the Respondent on October 9, 2013. A contested case hearing in this matter is scheduled for January 8, 2014.
5. Respondent disputes the charges and denies the allegations in the Statement of Charges, but acknowledges that the allegations, if proven in a contested case proceeding, would constitute grounds for the discipline agreed to in this Order.
6. Execution of this Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case. Respondent has a right to a hearing on the charges, but waives his right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to appeal, by freely and voluntarily agreeing to this Order. Once entered, this Order shall have the force and effect of a disciplinary order entered following a contested case hearing.
7. Respondent is freely and voluntarily entering into this Order.
8. Respondent acknowledges that he has a right to be represented by counsel on this matter.
9. The State's legal counsel may present this Order to the Board *ex parte*.

10. This Order is subject to approval by a majority of the full Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either the Board or Respondent. If the Board approves this Order, it shall be the full and final resolution of this matter.
11. This Order shall be part of the permanent record of Respondent and shall be considered by the Board in determining the nature and severity of any disciplinary action to be imposed in the event of any future violations.
12. This Order, when fully executed, is a public record and is available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapters 22 and 272C.
13. The Board's approval of this Order shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


14. Respondent agrees to **VOLUNTARILY SURRENDER** his license to practice as a chiropractor to resolve this matter.
15. This voluntary surrender, when accepted by the Board, has the same force and effect as an order of revocation under 645 Iowa Administrative Code rule 12.1(5).
16. Respondent shall surrender his chiropractic license to the Board within ten (10) days of the Board's approval of this Order.
17. Respondent agrees not to use any words or titles which imply or represent that he is a licensed chiropractor, or to otherwise hold himself out to the public as a licensed chiropractor, or to engage in the practice of chiropractic for which a license is required in the State of Iowa.
18. Should Respondent violate the terms of this Order, the Board may initiate action to impose other licensee discipline as authorized by Iowa Code chapters 272C and 151 and 645 Iowa Administrative Code chapters 13 and 45.
19. Respondent may not request reinstatement for at least one year from the date of this Order. Respondent may request reinstatement of his Iowa chiropractic license after one year by filing an application for reinstatement under 645 Iowa Administrative Code rules 11.31 and 41.15. Respondent's license shall not be reinstated except upon a showing by Respondent that the basis for revocation of his license no longer exists, and that it is in the public interest for the license to be reinstated.

This Settlement Agreement and Final Order is voluntarily submitted by Respondent to the Board for its consideration on the 10th day of January, 2014
