Request for Application (RFA) Fiscal Year 2014**

**Amendment 2
March 5, 2013**

Effective immediately, the Community Partnerships for Tobacco Use Prevention and Control Request for Application Fiscal Year 2014 is amended to correct the minimum number of market rate properties based on population due to a typo.

Section 2.01 – Scope and Description of Services, last bullet on page 11 is corrected as follows:

- Assess any market rate housing properties in each county of service area and enter any property that has at least one 100% SF building with no grandfathered tenants into the SurveyMonkey tool provided by IDPH. IDPH will NOT supply a market rate database of market rate properties in contractor's service area. Contractors will be required to do the research locally.

A training will be planned on outreach, assessment, and reporting through SurveyMonkey within first quarter of FY 14.

In counties with a population < 10,000, contractor will assess a minimum of 5 market rate properties.

In counties with a population of 10,001 to ~~15,000~~ **25,000**, contractor will assess a minimum of 10 market rate properties.

In counties with a population of 25,001 to 50,000, contractor will assess a minimum of 20 market rate properties.

In counties with a population of 50,001 or more, contractor will assess a minimum of 40 market rate properties.

All other terms and conditions of the RFA and RFP remain in effect.
