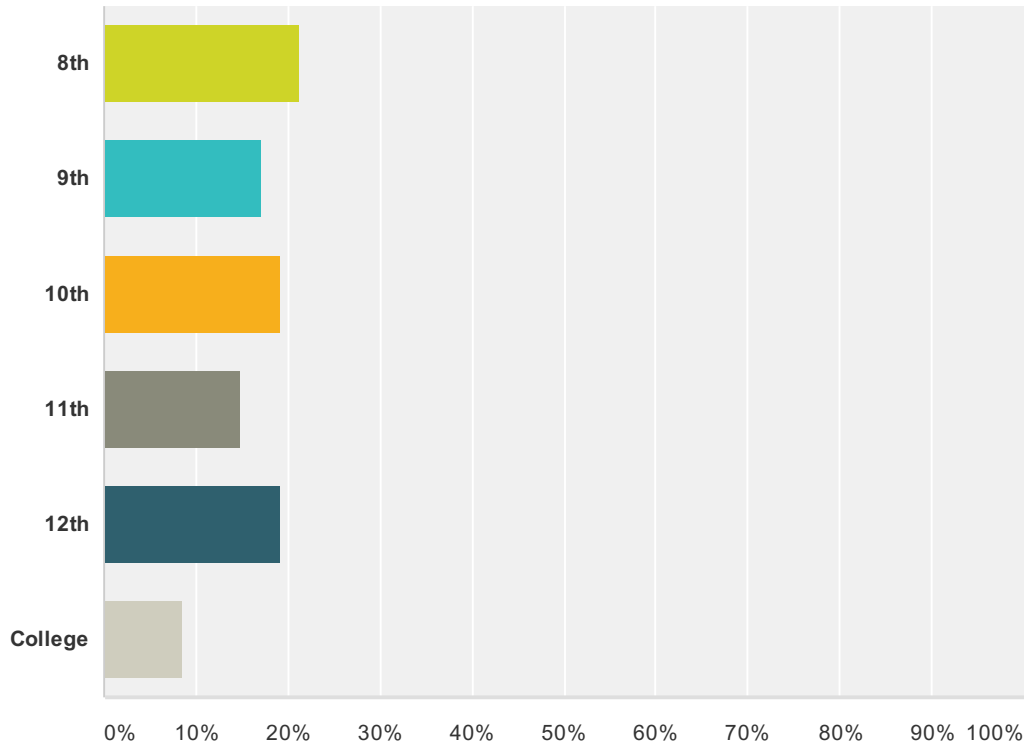

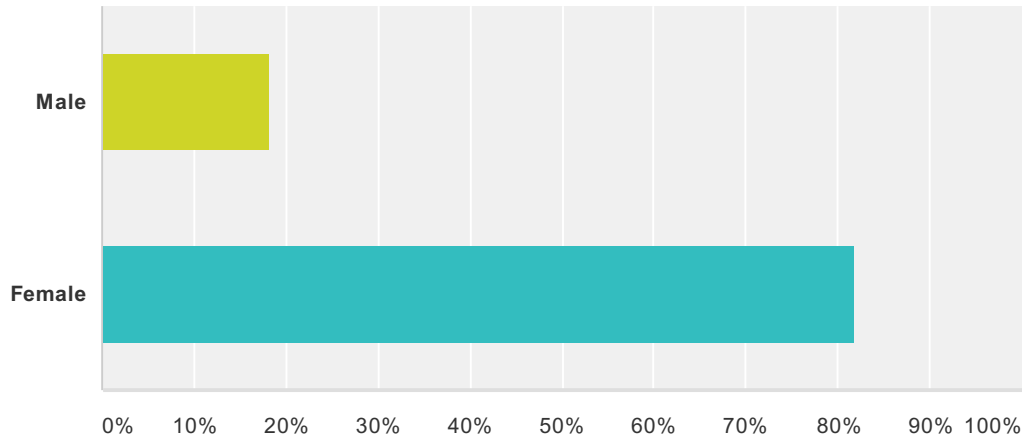

Q2 What is your Gender?

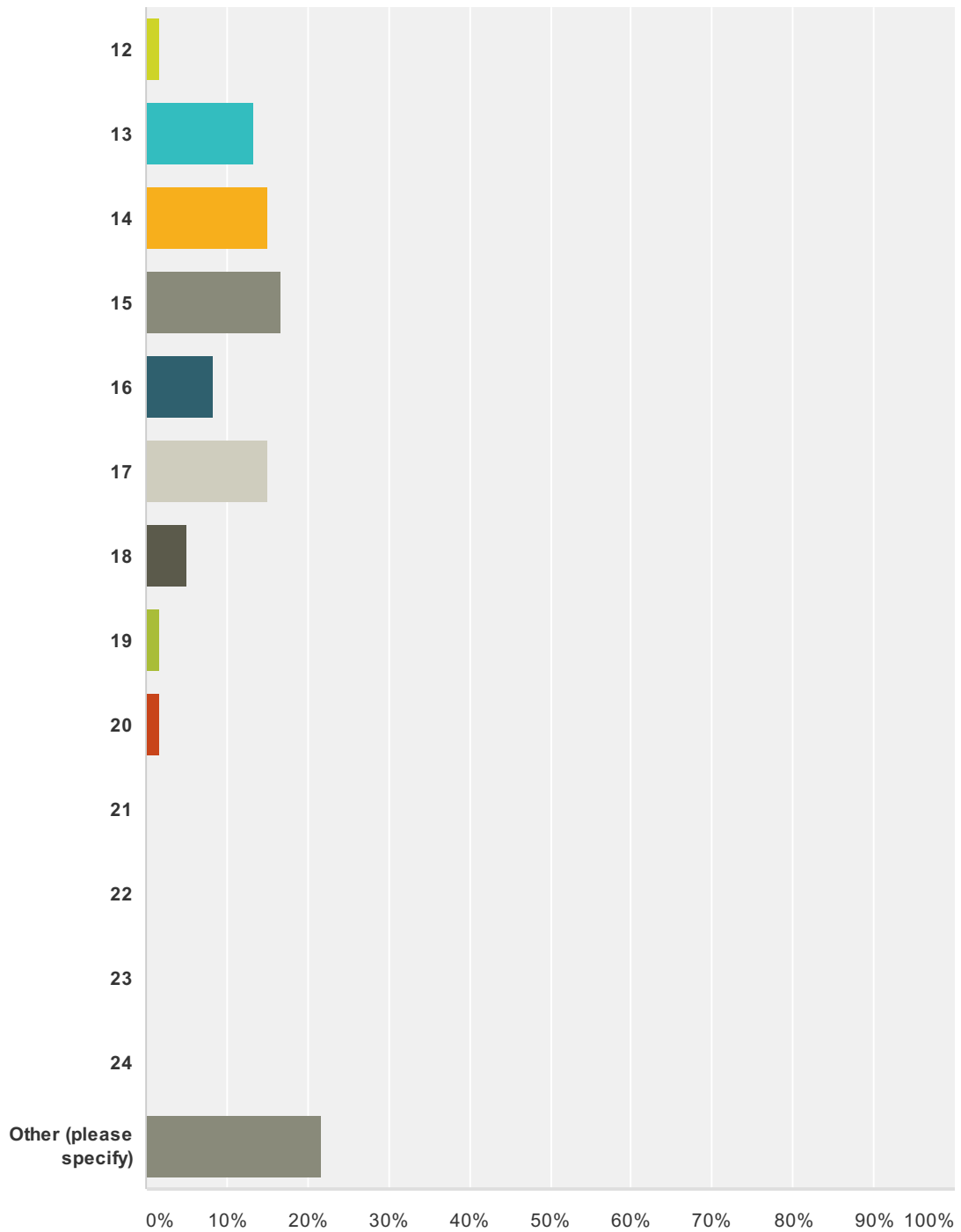

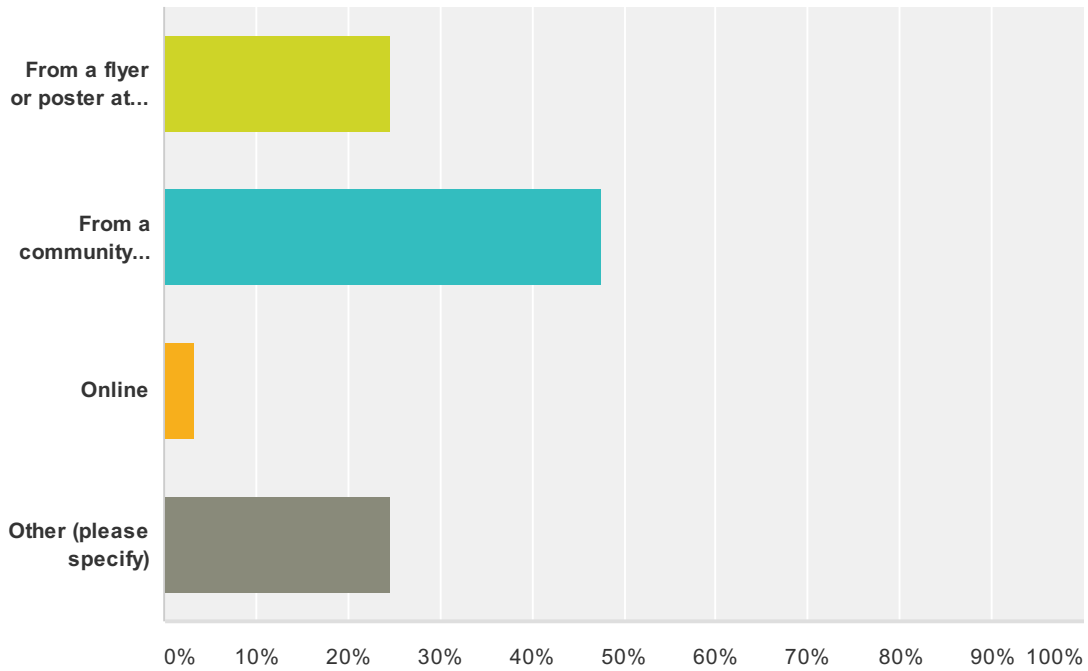

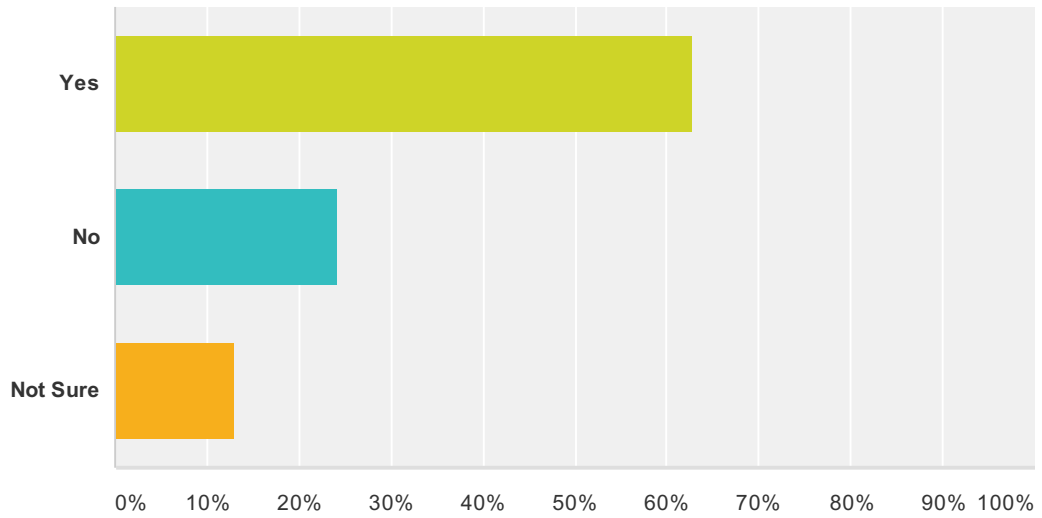

Q7 Do you have a youth chapter that works on tobacco prevention locally?

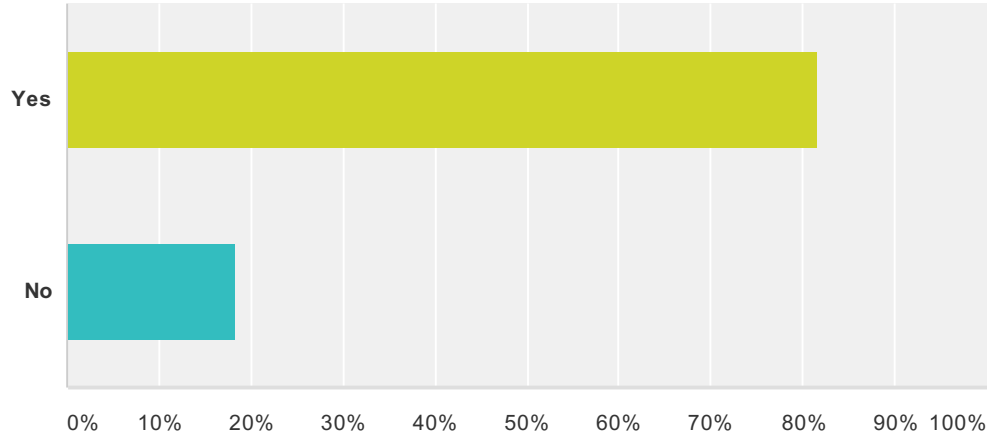

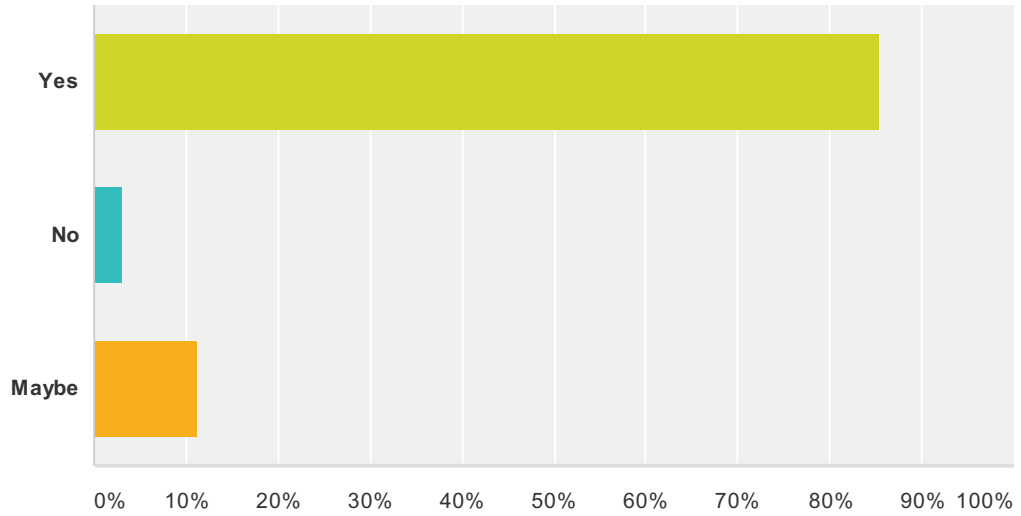

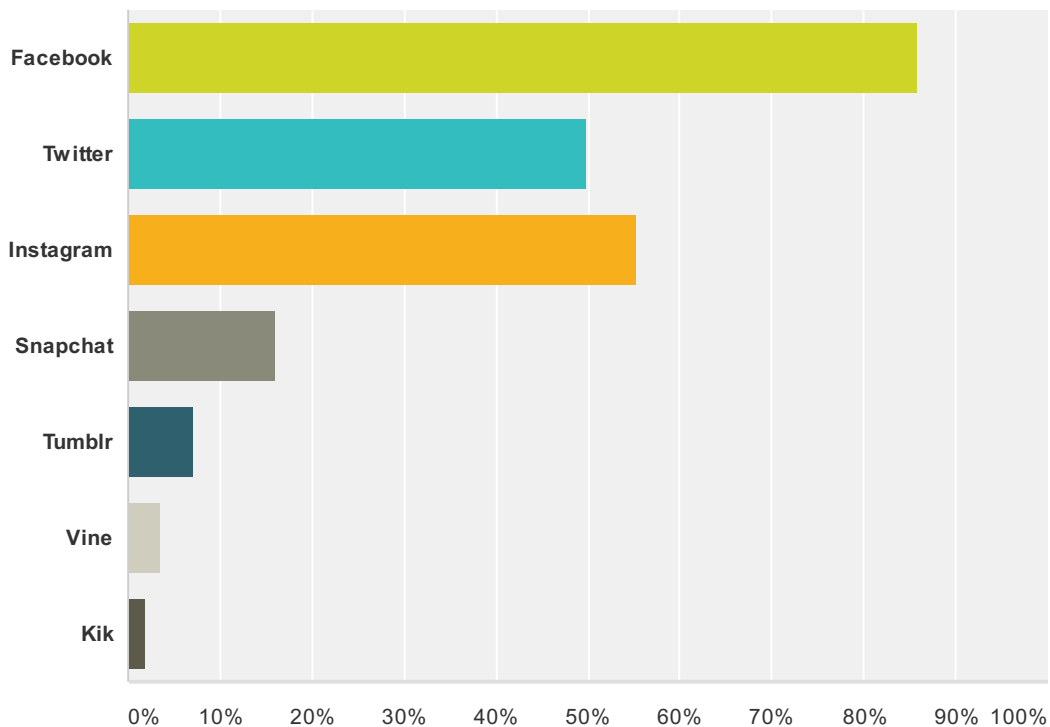
