Iowa Pertussis Update

Overview:


There are approximately 461% more persons with pertussis disease this year compared to the average of the past five years (the five year average is 242 and 1358 cases have been reported so far in 2012). Historically, pertussis activity has been cyclical with increased activity observed every three to five years; therefore the current activity is not unexpected. High levels of activity last occurred in 2004 (1066 cases reported) and 2005 (1106 cases reported), and the number of cases also increased moderately in 2010. No pertussis-related deaths have been reported to IDPH this year.
