

That same www.quitlineiowa.org planning can be applied to healthy rural and farm living choices. The health and safety tent will feature displays to help you make healthy living choices. If quitting tobacco is in your plan come and find out about Quitline Iowa. Quitline Iowa offers tobacco cessation coaching services over the telephone or the Internet, 24 hours a day. For more information about Quitline Iowa, visit www.quitlineiowa.org or call 1-800-QUIT-NOW or stop by our Tobacco Use Prevention and Control booth. Quitline Iowa is now offering eight weeks of free nicotine replacement therapy (NRT) in the form of patch, gum or lozenge to Iowans over the age of 18 that would like to guit using tobacco. Quitline Iowa also offers free telephone coaching for youth 13-17 years of age who want to quit. In Iowa, 18.1 percent of adults smoke. Tobacco is the leading cause of death for Iowans, taking the lives of more than 4,400 adults each year. The estimated annual Iowa health care costs directly associated with tobacco use now total \$1 **Iowa Department of Public Health** The Host of the Health & Safety Tent.
