Counseling, Testing, and Referral Sites

Counseling, testing, and referral (CTR) sites offer confidential, free or low-cost HIV testing to individuals to determine if they are infected with HIV. For those that test positive, this awareness can motivate them to take steps to protect their health and the health of their partners. The CTR sites will ensure that these individuals are referred to the appropriate caregivers. For those whose HIV tests are negative, the testing process is an opportunity to get the information needed to stay uninfected. Call for testing times or to make an appointment.





HIV/AIDS Resources/Services

AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)

The Iowa AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) provides medications for the treatment of HIV to low-income Iowans living with HIV.

If you are living with HIV and do not have adequate health insurance or the financial resources necessary to cover the cost of medications, ADAP may be able to assist you.

The Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) HIV/AIDS Program administers the ADAP program in Iowa. Iowa utilizes a central pharmacy system located in Pleasant Hill, Iowa.

Since 1998, the program has provided HIV medications to over 850 Iowans. Medications are mailed directly to the patient or provider. The pharmacy processes approximately 9,900 prescriptions per year to over 400 individual clients.
