Standard Heating and Air Conditioning is asking for a waiver due to mix up when applications were delivered to Board Meeting. Applications were not received back in Plumbing and Mechanical Systems Board Office. Documentation provided by company was reviewed at a separate meeting and members who attended provided their understanding and recommended granting waivers due to strong evidence that intent was to submit applications.
