NOTICE OF PROPOSED DENIAL OF  
APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION  
AS LEAD SAFE RENOVATOR

Pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code Sections 135.105A and Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 641—70.10(2), the Iowa Department of Public Health (Department) is proposing to deny your application to become a certified lead safe renovator.

Iowa Code Section 135.105A(5) states: "The department shall adopt rules regarding minimum requirements for training programs, certification, work practice standards, and suspension and revocation requirements, and shall implement the training and certification programs."

Iowa Administrative Code section 70.10(1) states: "When the department finds that the applicant, certified lead professional, certified elevated blood lead (EBL) inspection agency, or certified firm has committed any of the following acts, the department may deny an application for certification . . ."

*r.* Falsified reports and records required by this chapter.

*ab.* Been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor related to lead professional activities or the conviction of any felony or misdemeanor that would affect the ability of the firm or individual to perform lead professional activities. A copy of the record of conviction or plea of guilty shall be conclusive evidence.

*ac.* Unethical conduct.

On April 15, 2011, the Department received your application for certification as a lead safe renovator. In this application, you answered "yes" to the following questions:

"Have you ever been convicted of, found guilty of, or entered a plea of no contest to a felony or misdemeanor crime (other than minor traffic violations with fines under \$100)?"

You did not provide any additional information as directed in the application. According to online records you have been convicted of the following crimes:

- 2010 – Lascivious acts with child – felony  
Lascivious acts with child – felony  
Lascivious acts solicitation – felony

You are currently in prison and registered sex offender in Iowa.


**Therefore, the Department is proposing to deny your application to be certified as a lead safe renovator.**

**You have the right to request a hearing concerning this Notice of Proposed Denial of Application for Certification.** A request for a hearing must be submitted in writing to the Department by certified mail, return receipt requested, within twenty (20) days of this Notice of Proposed Denial of Application for Certification. The written request must be sent to:



If the request is made within the twenty (20) day time limit, the proposed action is suspended pending the outcome of the hearing. Prior to or at the hearing, the Department may rescind the notice upon satisfaction that the reason for the action has been or will be removed.

**If no request for a hearing is received within the twenty (20) day time period, the disciplinary action proposed herein shall become effective and shall be final agency action.**
