The Iowa Board of Massage Therapy (Board) and Chad Gilson (Applicant) enter into this Agreement and Consent Order (Agreement) pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10, 152C.3, and 272C.3 (2008).

1. On November 18, 2008, Applicant made application for an Iowa license to practice massage therapy.

2. In reviewing Applicant's application and supporting documentation, the following information came to the Board's attention:

a. In 1998, Applicant was charged with a misdemeanor for possession of a controlled substance, marijuana.

b. In May 2000, Applicant was found guilty of controlled substance violation. The applicant reported he received a deferred judgment of for the possession of marijuana and it was revoked in November 2001 and given probation.

c. In June 2000 Applicant was found guilty for a simple misdemeanor, disorderly conduct.

d. In 2006 Applicant was arrested for possession of marijuana, and given two – five years of probation.

3. The Board and the Applicant agree to issuance of a massage therapy license to Applicant, effective the date this Consent Agreement is signed by the chairperson of the Board, under the following terms and conditions:

a. Applicant shall be required to complete a continuing education course in the area of ethics within six months of the signing of this Agreement.

b. Applicant shall provide the Board with verification of completion of this course within six months of the signing of this Agreement by sending a copy of the certificate of completion for the required ethics course and a cover letter explaining that the certificate is proof of his complying with the consent agreement.

4. In the event Applicant violates or fails to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Agreement, the Board may initiate appropriate action to revoke or suspend Applicant's license or to impose other discipline as authorized by law.

5. This Consent Agreement constitutes the resolution of a pending license application proceeding.

6. This Consent Agreement is voluntarily submitted by Applicant to the Board.

7. This Consent Agreement is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Consent Agreement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

8. This Agreement is a public record available for copying and inspection pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 22 and 272C.

8. The Board's approval of this Consent Agreement shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.

This consent agreement is approved by the board on September 24, 2009.
