COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Barber Examiners (Board) and Terrance J. Soto (Applicant), and agree to the issuance of a temporary permit to practice as a barber in Iowa. Upon passing the state exam, the applicant will be issued a probationary license to be in effect until June 21, 2006.

- 1. The applicant will take the state exam on January 24, 2005.
- 2. Upon passing the state exam, he will be issued a probationary license to be in effect until June 21, 2006.
- 3. The Applicant agrees to keep his license current during his periods of employment as a barber in the state of Iowa. Within 15 days of the notification of the Board's approval of this Agreement, the Applicant shall notify the Board in writing as to the status of his employment as a barber in the State of Iowa. The Applicant shall also notify the Board in writing within 15 days of the occurrence of any changes in his employment status as a barber in the State of Iowa. All written notifications required by this provision shall include:
 - a) The name and address of the Applicant's places of employment as a barber, including any barber shop or salon owned or operated by the Applicant;
 - b) Each employer's barber shop or cosmetology salon license number; and
 - c) The Applicant's date of hire as a barber, and if applicable, the date his employment is terminated.

If the Applicant is not employed as a barber in the State of Iowa, he shall so notify the Board. Failure by the Applicant to timely and truthfully notify the Board of his current employment status as a barber in the State of Iowa shall constitute a violation of this Agreement.

This agreement shall be part of the permanent record of the Applicant.

- 4. The applicant shall obey all federal, state, and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of barbering in Iowa.
- 5. In the event the applicant leaves Iowa to reside or to practice outside the state, the applicant shall notify the Board in writing of the dates of departure and return. Periods of residence or practice outside Iowa will not apply to the duration of this Consent Agreement.
- 6. Upon full compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Consent Agreement and upon expiration of the period of probation, the applicant's license shall be restored to its full privileges free and clear of the terms of probation.
- 7. This Consent Agreement is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Consent Agreement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
- 8. This Consent Agreement is voluntarily submitted by the applicant to the Board for consideration.

WHEREFORE, the terms of this consent agreement are agreed to and this settlement is entered into by the Iowa Board of Barber Examiners and the Applicant.

This Consent Agreement is approved by the board on December 23, 2004.
