CONSENT AGREEMENT

Applicant.

The Iowa Board of Hearing Aid Dispensers (Board) and Steven Bryce Stoney (Applicant), enter into this Consent Agreement (Agreement) pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 (2009), 272C.3(1) and 154A.4, and Iowa Administrative Code regulation 646-121.2.

The Applicant seeks a temporary permit to practice under the supervision of a hearing aid dispenser in the State of Iowa. The Board received the application for a temporary permit on December 11, 2009.

1. The Applicant reported three misdemeanor convictions on the application for a temporary permit.
2. The Applicant submitted a June 18, 1996 Order of Probation case no. CR96-12242 DUI 1st (\$200 fine, 180 days probation), a May 15, 1997 Order of Probation case no. CR97-1133 DUI-second offense (\$200 fine and 48 hours in jail, 18 months probation), and a December 30, 1999, Order of Probation in case no. CR99-17945, DUI - third/more offense (\$600 fine and 7 days in jail, 36 months probation).
3. The applicant also affirmed an August 11, 1997 conviction in case no. 03211 OWCR008858, Consumption/intoxication ((\$50 fine), and Disorderly conduct (\$50 fine).

4. The Applicant has satisfied all other requirements for the issuance of a temporary permit.
5. Upon approval of this Agreement by the Board, the Applicant shall receive a restricted temporary permit subject to the conditions specified in this Agreement.
6. The Applicant shall comply with all requirements for temporary permit holders and supervision of persons who hold a temporary permit as set forth by Iowa law.
7. Within 90 days of the execution date of this Agreement by the Board, the Applicant shall undergo a substance abuse evaluation from Heartland Family Service, 515 E. Broadway, Council Bluffs, Iowa; Telephone (712) 322-1407. Prior to the date of the evaluation, the Applicant shall provide the Board with the date of the evaluation, and shall provide the evaluator with copies of this Agreement, the convictions, the Applicant's written account of the circumstances of the convictions, and any other documents as determined necessary by the evaluator. Any costs incurred for complying with this requirement will be the Applicant's responsibility. The Applicant shall inform the Board of the date of the evaluation and shall cause the results of the evaluation to be forwarded from the evaluator to the Board. The Applicant shall comply with any recommendations made in the evaluation report, including any recommendations regarding restrictions on his temporary permit.
8. Should the Applicant violate the terms of this Consent Agreement in any respect, the Board may institute formal disciplinary action against the Applicant, or may deny a permanent license.

9. This Agreement is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Agreement, it shall be of no force or effect on either party.
10. The Applicant voluntarily submits this Agreement to the Board for its consideration.
11. This Agreement is a public record available for inspection and copying in accordance with Iowa law.

WHEREFORE, the terms of this Consent Agreement are agreed to and accepted by the Iowa Board of Hearing Aid Dispensers and the Applicant.

This consent agreement is approved by the board on March 16, 2010.
