YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REQUEST A HEARING. YOU HAVE 30 DAYS TO DO SO.

IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, YOU WILL BE ASSESSED A FINE AS STATED BELOW.

COMES NOW the Iowa Plumbing and Mechanical Systems Board (Board) and hereby files this Notice of Intent to Impose Civil Penalties pursuant to Iowa Code section 105.27 and 641 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 32.5. Respondent is not licensed to perform plumbing or mechanical services in the state of Iowa.

A. LEGAL AUTHORITY AND JURISDICTION

Jurisdiction. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code sections 272C.3 and 105.27.

<u>Legal Authority</u>. Pursuant to Iowa Code sections 105.27, the Board has authority to issue an order imposing a civil penalty up to \$5000 for practices made unlawful by chapter 105.

B. SECTIONS OF STATUTES AND RULES INVOLVED

Iowa Code section 105.10 requires all persons who perform plumbing and mechanical services in the State of Iowa to possess a license issued by the Board.

Under 641 IAC 32.5(1)(a) the following is an unlawful practice:

"Acts or practices by unlicensed persons which require licensure to install or repair plumbing, HVAC, refrigeration, or hydronic systems."

Announcing to the public in any way (the use of any sign, card, circular, device, vehicle, or advertisement) the intention to provide any service for which a license is required is prima facie evidence of engaging in the practice of a plumber or mechanical professional. Iowa Code § 105.29

C. FACTUAL CIRCUMSTANCES

- Respondent has never been issued a license by the Board.
- 2. Respondent has advertised that he performs plumbing and HVAC work.

D. AMOUNT OF CIVIL PENALTY

The Board intends to issue an Order Imposing Civil Penalty in the amount of \$500.1

E. RIGHT TO HEARING, WAIVER OF HEARING, ISSUANCE OF ORDER

Hearing. You are entitled to a hearing in this matter upon timely, written request. To be timely, a request for hearing must be made within **30 days** of the date you receive this notice or are served this notice. Mail your written hearing request to the following address:

A hearing held in this matter shall be open to the public.

¹ This is equal to the licensure fee for two master licenses (HVAC & plumbing).

Waiver of Hearing. At any time before or after requesting a hearing in accordance with 641 IAC 32.5, and upon mutual consent of the Board, you may waive the right to hearing and all attendant rights and enter into a Consent Order imposing a civil penalty and requiring compliance with Iowa Code chapter 105.

Issuance of Order. If a request for hearing is not timely made, the board chairperson or the chairperson's designee may issue the Order Imposing Civil Penalty. If this occurs and you fail to pay the civil penalty within thirty (30) days, the Board shall notify the Attorney General, who may commence an action to recover the amount of the penalty, including reasonable attorney fees and costs.

E. OTHER ENFORCEMENT

Nothing in this Notice prevents the Board from seeking an injunction against you in the district court, or referring the matter for criminal prosecution.

F. CEASE AND DESIST

You must immediately cease any practice for which a license is required under Chapter 105. You must not engage in the installation and repair of plumbing, HVAC, refrigeration, or hydronic systems.

G. PROBABLE CAUSE FINDING

On this 19th day of April, 2011, the Iowa Plumbing and Mechanical Systems Board found probable cause to file this Notice of Intent to Impose Civil Penalty.
