COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Physical & Occupational Therapy (Board) and files this Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.12(2), 17A.18(3), and 645 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 11.6.

Respondent was issued Iowa license 00941 on May 30, 2003. Respondent's license is current and will next expire on August 15, 2013. Respondent's address as reported to the Board is 6711 Giles Road Apartment 15, Papillion, Nebraska, 68133.

A. TIME, PLACE AND NATURE OF HEARING

Hearing. A disciplinary contested case hearing shall be held on **June 15, 2012**, before the Board of Physical & Occupational Therapy. The hearing shall begin at **9:00 a.m.** and shall be located in the Lucas State Office Building, Fifth Floor Board Conference Room 526, Des Moines, Iowa.

Answer. Within twenty (20) days of the date you are served this Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges you are required by 645 IAC 11.12 to file an Answer. The Answer should specifically admit, deny, or otherwise answer all allegations contained in sections C and D of this Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges. Pleadings shall be filed with the Board at the following address: Board of Physical & Occupational Therapy, 5th Floor, Lucas State Office Building, Des Moines, Iowa, 50319.

<u>Presiding Officer</u>. The Board shall serve as presiding officer, but the Board may request an Administrative Law Judge make initial rulings on pre-hearing matters, and be present to assist and advise the board at hearing.

Hearing Procedures. The procedural rules governing the conduct of the hearing are found at 641 IAC chapter 11. At hearing, you may appear personally or be represented by legal counsel at your own expense. You will be allowed the opportunity to respond to the charges against you, to produce evidence on your behalf on issues of material fact, cross-examine witnesses present at the hearing, and examine and respond to any documents introduced at hearing. If you need to request an alternative time or date for hearing, you must comply with the requirements of 645 IAC 11.18. The hearing may be open to the public or closed to the public at your discretion.

<u>Pre-hearing Conference</u>. Any party may request a pre-hearing conference to discuss evidentiary issues related to the hearing. The Board's rules regarding pre-hearing conferences are contained at 645 IAC 11.17.

<u>Prosecution</u>. The Office of the Attorney General is responsible for representing the public interest (the State) in this proceeding. Copies of pleadings should be provided to counsel for the State at the following address: September Lau, Assistant Attorney General, Iowa Attorney General's Office, 2nd Floor, Hoover State Office Building, Des Moines, Iowa 50319.

Communications. You may not contact board members in any manner, including by phone, letter, or e-mail, about this Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges.

Board members may only receive information about the case when all parties have notice and an opportunity to participate, such as at the hearing or in pleadings you file

with the Board office and serve upon all parties in the case.

B. LEGAL AUTHORITY AND JURISDICTION

<u>Jurisdiction</u>. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 147, 148A, and 272C.

<u>Legal Authority</u>. If any of the allegations against you are founded, the Board has authority to take disciplinary action against you under Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 147, 148A, and 272C and 645 IAC chapter 202.

<u>Default</u>. If you fail to appear at the hearing, the Board may enter a default decision or proceed with the hearing and render a decision in your absence, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 17A.12(3) and 645 IAC 11.21.

C. SECTIONS OF STATUTES AND RULES INVOLVED

Count I

Respondent is charged under Iowa Code § 147.55(9) and 645 IAC 202.2(22) with "failure to submit the required report of continuing education." Under 645 IAC 4.11(1), "Licensees shall provide information to the board for auditing purposes as follows: The licensee shall provide an individual certificate of completion issued to the licensee or evidence of successful completion of the course from the course sponsor. [This information] must be submitted within 30 days after the date on the letter of notification of the audit."

D. FACTUAL CIRCUMSTANCES

- 1. Respondent is licensed to practice as a physical therapy assistant in the state of lowa. Her license is active and expires August 15, 2013.
 - 2. Respondent renewed her license August 8, 2011, and was selected for a

post renewal continuing education audit.

- 3. On September 19, 2011, the Board sent to Respondent notification of the audit. Pursuant to the audit, Respondent was required to submit documentation evincing successful completion of all required continuing education hours by October 19, 2011.
- 4. As of March 15, 2012, Respondent has failed to submit the required documentation.

E. SETTLEMENT

This matter may be resolved by settlement agreement. The procedural rules governing the Board's settlement process are found at 645 IAC chapter 12. If you are interested in pursuing settlement of this matter, please contact September Lau, Assistant Attorney General, at 515/281-7175.
