COME NOW the Iowa Board of Social Work Examiners ("Board") and Bruce Enger ("Respondent"), and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4) (2005), enter into the following Settlement Agreement and Final Order of the contested case currently on file.

1. Respondent was issued license number 03652 to practice as a master level social worker in the state of Iowa on June 9, 1998. Respondent's license expired on December 31, 2000.
2. Respondent's current address as reported to the Board is 1716 Cedar Street, Davenport, Iowa, 52804.
3. The Board has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter.
4. A Statement of Charges was filed against the Respondent on November 14, 2005, and is scheduled for hearing on May 8, 2006.
5. Execution of this Settlement Agreement and Final Order constitutes the resolution of this contested case. Respondent has a right to a hearing on the charges, but waives his right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to appeal, by freely and voluntarily agreeing to this Settlement Agreement and Final Order. Once entered, this Order shall have the force and effect of a disciplinary order entered following contested case hearing.

6. Respondent is freely and voluntarily entering into this Settlement Agreement and Final Order, and he agrees that the State's counsel may present this agreement to the Board.

7. This agreement is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board approves this agreement, it becomes the final disposition of this matter. If the Board fails to approve this agreement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

8. This agreement shall be part of the permanent record of Respondent and shall be considered by the Board in determining the nature and severity of any disciplinary action to be imposed in the event of any future violations.

9. This Settlement Agreement and Final Order as well as the Statement of Charges are public records available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapter 22.

10. The Board's approval of this agreement shall constitute a FINAL ORDER of the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

11. Respondent agrees to immediately submit a renewal application and all required fees to renew his expired master level social work license. Respondent agrees that from the date of this agreement forward he shall not utilize any designation, abbreviation, or title which implies that Respondent is licensed to practice social work or otherwise hold himself out to be a licensed social worker or engage in any activity or practice of social work in the state of Iowa for which a license is required unless he maintains a current, active license to practice.

12. Following issuance of his master level license, Respondent's license shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years subject to the following terms and conditions:

a. Respondent shall remit to the Board a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$ 1000.00) made payable to the Treasurer, State of Iowa, within ninety (90) days of the date of this agreement.

b. Respondent shall fully cooperate in announced or random unannounced reviews, evaluations, or office visits by the Board or agents of the Board.

c. Respondent shall upon reasonable notice appear before the Board at the time and place designated by the Board. Respondent agrees that any meeting between himself and a Board member or members shall not constitute "personal investigation" or otherwise disqualify a Board member from acting as a presiding officer in any subsequent case.

d. Respondent shall obey all federal, state, and local statutes and regulations governing the practice of social work.

e. Respondent shall notify the Board of any change in address within one week of said change.

f. Upon full compliance with the terms and conditions for probation set forth in this Settlement Agreement and Final Order, the Respondent's probation shall be terminated.

13. In the event the Respondent violates or fails to comply with any of the terms or provisions of this Settlement Agreement and Final Order, the Board may

initiate appropriate action to revoke or suspend the Respondent's license or to impose

other licensee discipline as authorized by Iowa Code section 272C.3(2)(a).

This notice of hearing is approved by the Board on May 8, 2006.
