Employees who will work with tanning customers are required to be trained by the owner/manager initially and every 5 years thereafter. Please use the Training Program manual and IDPH Health Warnings sent with your registration packet and the enclosed test to train each employee. Follow the directions on the test carefully. Copy the test as many times as needed as we do not provide multiple copies. Do not return any testing material to IDPH for scoring. You can also find the Training Program manual, IDPH Health Warnings, and this test on our website: www.idph.state.ia.us. Click on "A-Z index", "T", "Tanning facilities."

All tests should be kept on file at the facility for review by the inspector during facility inspections. Make sure all signatures and dates are complete. Any operator may be questioned about items in the training material during an inspection.

This notice does not apply to owner/manager testing which must be completed at the county health department responsible for the facility inspections.

We appreciate your cooperation in making this program work. The alternative is traveling and paying a fee to take a monitored test. Please let me know if you have any questions.
