The Iowa Board of Mortuary Science (Board) and Jamie Stoner (Respondent) enter into this Consent Order (Order), pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(1) and 272C.3(4) (2009), and 645 Iowa Admin. Code 12.1:

1. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Iowa Code section 147.14(1)"p" and Iowa Code chapters 17A, 156, and 272C.
2. Respondent was issued Iowa license no. 02802 on August 18, 2001. That license expired on April 15, 2008 and is currently inactive, subject to reactivation.
3. The Board charged Respondent with: (a) engaging in practices potentially harmful or detrimental to the public, pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.10(3); (b) exhibiting a pattern of careless or intentional acts or omissions that demonstrates a lack of qualifications which are necessary to ensure a high standard of professional care, pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.3(2)"b"; (c) failure to respond to a continuing education audit, pursuant to 645 IAC 4.13(272C) and 103.3(8)"c"; and (d) suspension of his license to sell pre-need agreements under Iowa Code section 523A, pursuant to 645 IAC 103.3(8)"b" and "c".
4. Respondent has a right to a hearing on the charges, but waives his right to hearing and all attendant rights, including the right to seek judicial review, by freely and voluntarily entering

into this Order. This Consent Order is the final agency order in the contested case.

5. Respondent disputes the allegations, but affirmatively states that he has no intention of practicing mortuary science in the state of Iowa and accordingly is willing to permanently agree not to apply to reactivate his Iowa funeral director's license.

6. Respondent agrees the State's counsel may present this Order to the Board and may have ex parte communications with the Board solely for the purpose of presenting the Order.

7. This Order shall be part of the permanent record of Respondent and shall be considered by the Board in determining the nature and severity of any disciplinary action to be imposed in the event of any future violations.

8. This Order and the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges are public records available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapter 22 (2009).

9. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order shall be grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to Iowa Code section 272C.3(2)(a) (2009), or an action against an unlicensed person. However, no action may be taken against Respondent for violations of these provisions without an opportunity for hearing, or waiver of hearing.

10. This Order is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect on either party, and it shall not be admissible for any purpose in further proceedings in this matter. If the Board approves this Order, it shall fully dispose of all issues in this case.

11. This Order shall not preclude additional charges as to any new complaints received by the Board that are unrelated to the charges at issue in the Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jamie Stoner shall permanently refrain from applying to reactivate his Iowa funeral director's license, and that Mr. Stoner shall, within 20 days of the date this Consent Order is signed by all parties, either return his Iowa funeral director's certificate to the Board office, or submit a written statement that after diligent search the certificate could not be located.

Wherefore, the terms and conditions of this Consent Order are agreed to and accepted by the Iowa Board of Mortuary Science and the Respondent.

This consent order is approved by the board on March 12, 2009.
