The overall case count has decreased due to several cases not being laboratory-confirmed as having Cyclospora. They were confirmed to have Cryptosporidia or other artifact present on the slide.

Almost all cases have been identified through testing at the State Hygienic Lab (SHL). Most people's illness began in mid to late June, and at least seven persons have been hospitalized. Many people report still being ill with diarrhea and some have had relapses.
