APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Johnson moved and Dilley seconded the approval of the May 14, 2010 minutes. The motion carried.

REPORTS

Board Executive- Sharon Dozier reported the following:

The Rules Committee will meet in person today, as noted on the agenda. Representatives of IPA will attend. The ASPPB passwords have been given to all board members. The annual ASPPB meeting will be held on October 13 – 17, 2010. The out of state travel criteria was revised effective July 1; it is anticipated that Dozier will attend the board

executive component, and Payne will attend the board member orientation. ASPPB is providing a \$1000 subsidy and free meeting registration.

Bureau Chief- Barb Huey introduced herself. Her background includes serving as a county elected official, and her experience in state government includes positions in the Office of the Secretary of State and the IDPH Division of Administration and Professional Licensure. Huey noted changes in the Bureau due to budget cuts and the State Early Retirement Incentive Program (SERIP), including the loss of the bureau chief, two board executives, and an administrative assistant. The remaining three board executives have assumed additional board assignments during the interim. The only position that will not be replaced soon is one board executive position, but Huey hopes to receive approval to hire for this position in the near future.

AAG- Dozier noted that AAG Galenbeck is unable to attend the meeting, as he is out of state.

Chair- Brenda Payne stated that she is looking forward to attending ASPPB, as her planned trip last year was postponed due to the state's travel restrictions. Johnson made a motion for Payne to attend the ASPPB meeting. Glass seconded. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Committees-

Prescriptive Authority: John Dilley did not give a report. Payne noted that she is halfway through her training; she said there is no database of who is in the programs. Payne recognized Greg Febbraro of the IPA, who noted that Bethe Lonning is developing a plan, and information is being collected. Johnson suggested that a list of persons who have taken the training would be helpful.

Rules: Payne reported that the committee will meet today at Noon to continue reviewing information on postdoctoral experience, and states with rules that allow the experience to be resequenced. She hopes to have a document available to discuss at the November board meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Greg Febbraro said he will inform the IPA of the status of the board's review of resequencing.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

The amendments to the continuing education requirements in the common rules, Chapter 4, were reviewed. Glass made a motion to adopt the amendments, noticed as ARC 8784B. Langley seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

NEW BUSINESS

The board reviewed correspondence from licensees regarding continuing education. Johnson and Langley reviewed the syllabi from the applicants requesting approval for course preparation. Langley made a motion to approve the applications for continuing

education submitted by Wade Leuwerke, Judith Kaiser, Christine Novak, and Thomas Peterson. Dilley seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Henderson excused herself from the meeting.

COMPLAINTS

Johnson made a motion for closed session in accordance with Iowa Code section 21.5(1)"a" and "d." Dilley seconded the motion. Roll call vote:
