II. REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF NON-REVIEWABILITY AND THE DEPARTMENT'S RESPONSE

The purpose of the Council's review under this portion of the agenda is to determine whether it affirms the Department's determination that a project is or is not subject to review under Iowa Code chapter 135. The Council will review the Department's determination as to whether a project is exempt from review under Iowa Code sections 135.18 "g," "i" and "m." The Council will not hold a public hearing under this portion of the agenda.

1. SE Iowa Open MRI, Burlington, Lee County: Acquire MRI -- \$1,497,927.40.
2. University of Iowa Hospital's & Clinics, Iowa City, Johnson County: Purchase Intrabeam radiotherapy system for intraoperative breast irradiation -- \$371,850.

III. REQUEST FOR REHEARING

In the matter of the application of St. Luke's Hospital, Linn County to establish radiation therapy services through the purchase of an intraoperative radiotherapy system at an estimated cost of \$1,200,000. The Council granted a Certificate of Need for this project on October 19, 2011 and issued the written decision on December 20, 2011. Mercy Medical Center—Cedar Rapids, an affected party who appeared at hearing in opposition to the proposal, filed a request for rehearing on January 4, 2012, within 20 days after the date of the issuance of the final decision

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
