

Hepatitis A and B Vaccination

Thirteen health agencies provide hepatitis A and B vaccinations at no charge for at-risk clients. High-risk populations include people who were diagnosed with a sexually transmitted disease in the past 90 days, men who have sex with men, injection and non-injection drug users, HIV- and/or hepatitis C-infected persons, and sexual partners of persons infected with HIV, hepatitis A (HAV), and/or hepatitis B (HBV).
