

Salmonella St. Paul Update

March 23, 2009

The Iowa Dept. of Public Health (IDPH) continues working with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals, and surrounding states to investigate several cases of Salmonella that appear to be related to the consumption of alfalfa sprouts.

As of March 23, 2009, IDPH has identified 28 confirmed cases of Salmonella St. Paul related to this outbreak, along with 5 suspected cases.
