

On-Line MCART & UP Training Information for Child Care Providers

Mandatory Child Abuse Reporter Training (MCART)

- ❖ Two hours of approved training is required every five years for child care providers

Universal Precautions/Exposure Control Plan (UP/EC) Training

- ❖ One hour of approved training is required annually (for licensed child care center staff)
- ❖ One hour of approved training to meet continuing education requirements once every five years for child development home providers

When can I attend the new on-line training?

Any time! This is a self-study course that you can attend at your convenience. You must spend the **minimum required amount of time** taking the training, and you can spend additional time if necessary. You should not skip sections of the training. There will be an exam at the end of the course to document successful completion.

How do I sign up?

Each individual will need to create their own account with login and password. There are **no** group registrations or accounts. Once the account is created and the participant logs in, the course listing will open for you and you may select the appropriate course. Please keep your login and password information for the next

time you take one of these courses. Also, additional courses may be available at this location in the future. Child care center directors may want to help staff keep track of user names and passwords.

How do I find the course I want after logging in to my account?

After logging in, Click on the Course Catalog and search for the training you wish to take. For Mandatory Child Abuse Reporter training, search “mandatory.” For the Universal Precautions course, search “universal.” (see example below) After finding the course, click “enroll.”
